On December 1, 2016, The Leadership Coalition provided two hours of on-site training in leadership and team-building for Squadron 093 (Arlington) of the Civil Air Patrol, the official civilian auxiliary of the United States Air Force, which focuses on aerospace education, emergency services, and youth development.

The combination of classroom learning and practical experience provided a useful introduction to team-building. In particular, the Leadership Coalition staff focused on core leadership and teamwork concepts before challenging the students with physical obstacles designed to encourage communication, critical thinking and other teamwork skills.

Both the classroom instruction and the practical applications were engaging and informative, and I would confidently recommend the Leadership Coalition's content and approach to other young adults and youth programs.
